

## Further Information.....

### Who can take part?

Any person aged 15 to 18, involved in a Foróige Club, Project or Service, who has demonstrated good leadership skills and is eager to develop them further. You must be aged 15 or over by 25<sup>th</sup> July 2011.

### How much does it cost?

The cost of attending the conference is €250 per person. This cost includes all meals, accommodation, entertainment, transport and conference resources. This fee does not need to be paid until you have been formally offered a place.

### How do I apply?

Anyone interested in applying for a place, needs to complete an application form. You must also submit a fully completed nomination form. Applications will be assessed on the information supplied on the form, so please ensure you complete all sections fully.

### What is the deadline for application?

All completed applications must be received no later than **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May**. Late applications will not be accepted so please ensure you post early!

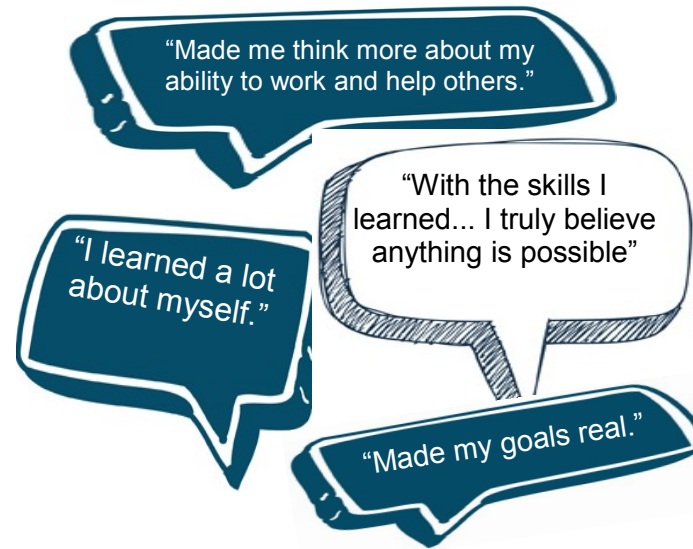
### When will I know if I have been successful?

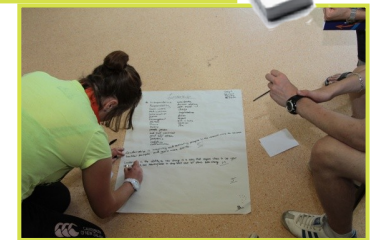
