As well as completing the above application form, applicants must agree to comply with the following:

1. Attend the **permanent tsb** Foróige Youth Citizenship Event closest to you in May. These take place in Dublin, Cork, Sligo and Offaly.
2. Complete sections 1 to 4 of the project report form in full to participate in these regional awards.
3. Showcase their projects on display boards at the awards.
4. Participate in all aspects of the regional awards.
5. Submit a permission form for attending the event signed by a parent or guardian on arrival at the event. This will include permission for photography and filming and will be supplied to you. Anyone who does not wish to be filmed or photographed must notify the citizenship programme officer in advance of the event.
6. Participate in any media opportunities associated with their project being involved in the regional awards.

In addition to the above stipulations, applicants who wish to be considered for the national awards must agree to comply with the following:

7. Complete sections the project report form in full, including section 5.
8. Participate in any additional activities which may be required on the day of the regional awards. You will be notified of this well in advance.
9. Be available for filming of your project in action on specified dates between May and October. Filming dates will be discussed with successful groups and assigned well in advance of filming. If your project is already complete, you will be required to re-create aspects of it.
10. Submit a permission form for filming and photography to be signed by their parent or legal guardian prior to commencement of filming. This will be supplied to you.
11. Be available for rehearsals as specified and for filming at The Helix in Dublin in October.
12. Participate in any media opportunities associated with their project being involved in the national televised awards.
13. Groups will be chosen, by a consultation panel, including Sideline Productions, to take part in the filming. However, at the discretion of Sideline Productions, whose remit is to provide an engaging TV show, not all groups will receive equal air time in the final edit.
14. Applicants must be prepared to accept the decision of the consultation panel in relation to the final selection of the groups to take part in the national awards. This decision is final and non-negotiable.
