YOUTH CITIZENSHIP AWARDS

Introduction to the Aldi Foróige Youth Citizenship Awards.

Foróige, in partnership with Aldi Ireland, is pleased to announce the Aldi Foróige Youth Citizenship Awards which are designed to give recognition to the huge contribution that young people make in their communities. It involves young people researching the needs of their community, organising practical action in response, evaluating the effectiveness of their work and reflecting on what they are learning along the way.

The Aldi Foróige Youth Citizenship Awards will give young people the opportunity to receive national recognition for their work in the community. The awards showcase all types of work young people have undertaken. This work may be in any form, such as a once off event or a long term project, and can make a difference to one person or a whole community anywhere in the world.

The format of the Aldi Foróige Youth Citizenship Awards is as follows:

All clubs/groups and individuals entering the Aldi Foróige Youth Citizenship Awards, will submit their project through the Project Report Form and all entrants will be invited to attend the Aldi Foróige Youth Citizenship Awards. Any club, project or individual who submits a project is eligible to participate in the Youth Citizenship Awards. The Youth Citizenship Awards will take place on **April 25th, 2020** in the **National Indoor Arena, National Sports Campus, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15**. It will be a fun filled day, not to be missed! More details of the event will be announced soon.

Criteria for Entry

- The Aldi Foróige Youth Citizenship Awards are open to young people between the ages

of 10 and 18 years at the time of entry. It is recommended that when completing a citizenship project that, where possible, the group should be either 10 – 12 year olds or 13 – 18 year olds. Individual applicants must also be between the ages of 10 -18 years.

- Clubs/Projects are allowed to submit unlimited group and individual entries to the Youth Citizenship Awards. However, each entry must be for a separate project/activity.
- Any entrants should have support from adult volunteers/youth work staff i.e. as a guide and facilitator.
- All Youth Citizenship Expo entries must relate to projects where a substantial amount of the work took place after May 1st 2019. The project must be completed by the time you submit your entry. Closing date for entries is **TBC**.

Registering for the Youth Citizenship

Register anytime using the official registration form but remember to keep in mind that the closing date for all citizenship report forms is **TBC**. Youth Citizenship Awards Categories

Enter your project under one of the following three categories:

- Group Award 13 years+
- Junior Group Award 10-12 years
- Individual Award 10-18 years only

Entering the Youth Citizenship Awards - Project Report Form

Once you have completed the online registration form you can then enter your project to the awards using the project report form. Reporting on your project using the project report form gives you the opportunity to describe what you did, how and why you did it and what you learned from the whole experience. The project report form and guidelines can be accessed once you have registered your project.
